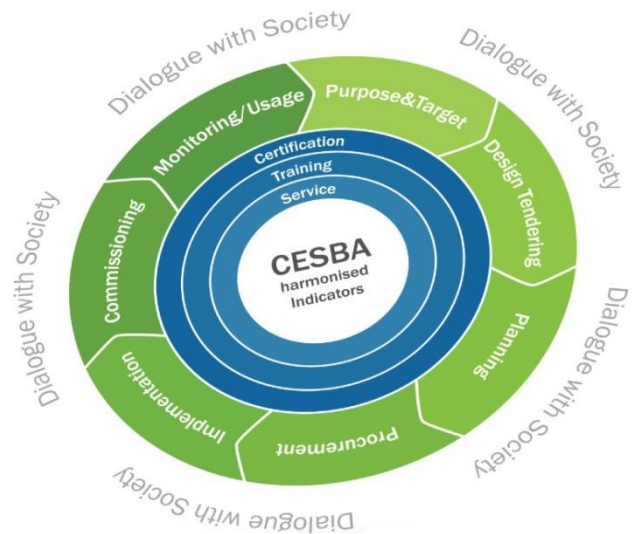

CESBA is a process towards a new culture and standards in Europe.

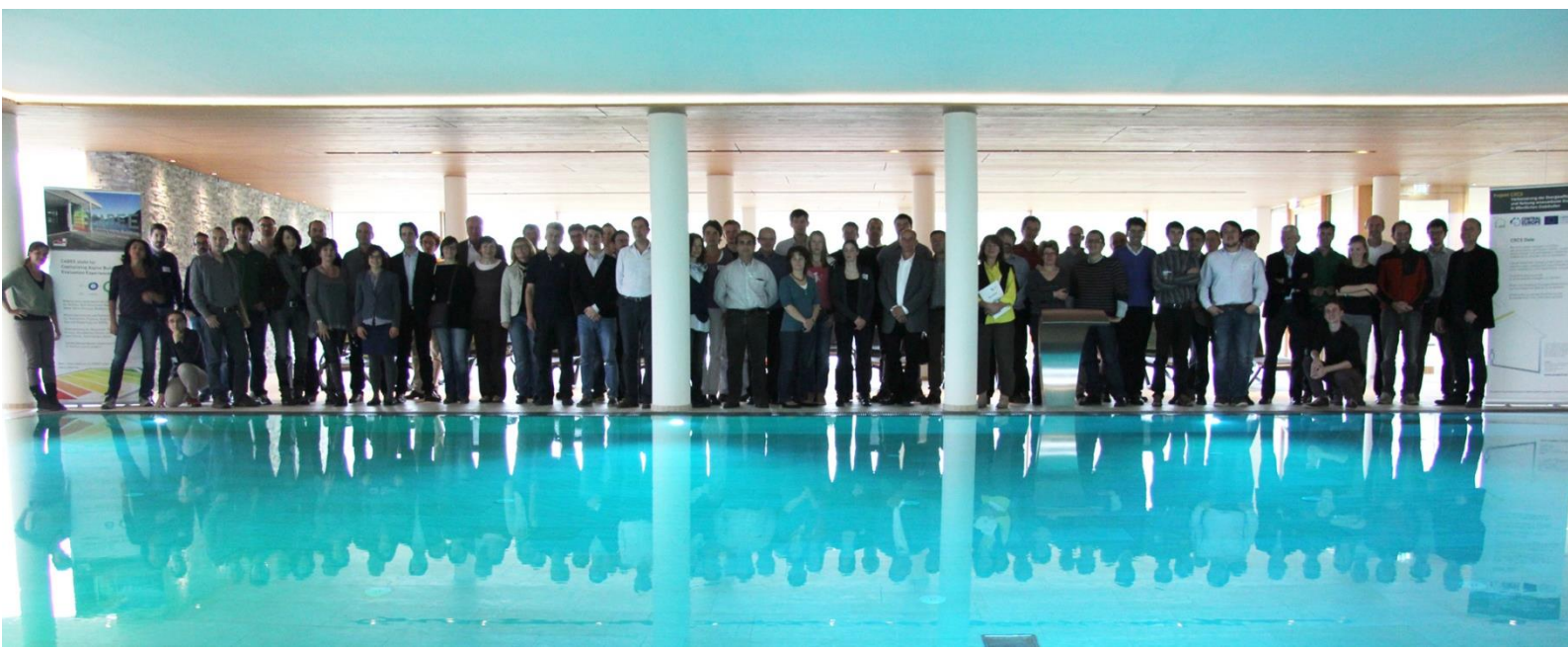


## ENJOY INSPIRED WORKING
